

FINAL ASSIGNMENT PRESENTATION: "MY OWN SUPERHERO"

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INSTRUCTIONS

In this assignment you are going to create your very own superhero! Your mission is to design a unique character who possesses extraordinary abilities and uses them to make the world a better place. Follow the steps below to complete your assignment:

CHARACTER CREATION:

- Brainstorm ideas for your superhero's name, appearance, powers, and costume.
- Consider what motivates your superhero to fight for justice and protect others.
- Think about any weaknesses or vulnerabilities your superhero may have.

BACKSTORY:

- Develop a backstory for your superhero, including how they acquired their powers and any significant events that shaped their character.
- Describe their childhood, family background, and any personal struggles they have overcome.

VILLAIN

- Present your villain. Develop a backstory for your superhero's nemesis, including their origins and reasons for becoming a villain.

POWERS AND ABILITIES:

- Define your superhero's unique powers and abilities in detail.
- Explain how they use their powers to fight crime, help others, or make a positive impact on society.

COSTUME:

- Describe the costume your superhero wears. How does it look and what abilities does it have?

PRESENTATION:

- Prepare a 5-7 minute oral presentation introducing your superhero to the class.
- Practice speaking clearly and confidently, and be prepared to answer questions from your classmates.

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HELPFUL SENTENCES

CHARACTER CREATION
